Dennis Allen True of Chester died on December 12, 2011 at the Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis. He was 56.

Born in Washington, DC on December 29, 1954, he was the son of the late, Courtney True and Theresa True Brown. He grew up in Prince George's County and began working in the HVAC industry. Dennis spent his career with the federal government for 29 ½ years, and retired as the Assistant Supervisor of Plumbing Division of the Architect of the Capital in November 2009.
