Dexter Randolph Case, Sr. of Stevensville, MD died Sunday, October 12, 2003 at the University of Maryland Medical Center, Baltimore, MD. He was 60.

Born on July 17, 1943 in Gowanda, NY, he was the son of Dorothy Dewey and the late Merris H. Case. Dexter attended school in Gowanda and Cattaraugus, NY. After graduation, he was employed by the USDA Soil Conservation Service (SCS) for 35 years. Dexter touched many hearts with his great sense of humor, his love of life and his ability to see the unique beauty in everything and everyone around him.

In addition to his mother, Dorothy Dewey of New York, he is survived by his wife Jeanne; a son, Dexter "Randy" Case, Jr. of New York; a daughter, Michele A.
