Diana Lynn Barnett of Stevensville, MD, died Thursday, January 8, 2015, at home. She was 68.

Born on June 4, 1946, in Baltimore, MD, the daughter of the late Jack Frederick Logan, Sr., and Mary Loretta Shewbridge, she grew up in Baltimore and moved to Kent Island with her family in 1979. She worked as a homemaker, caring for her children and supporting her husband.
