Diane Priest Stinchcomb of Stevensville, MD, died on July 12, 2000, at her parent's home in Arnold, MD. She was 48.

Born on March 24, 1952, in Washington, DC, the daughter of Robert W. and Jacqueline Millar Priest, Mrs. Stinchcomb was a graduate of Severna Park High School Class of 1970. In 1974, she received her degree in Dental Hygiene from the University of Maryland at Baltimore. She married Earl R. Stinchcomb on July 13, 1974.

Mrs. Stinchcomb began working for Dr. Ron Franks in Grasonville. She raised her family in Stevensville. During this time, she was a volunteer for Queen Anne's County Schools and was awarded as volunteer of the year in 1988. In 1996, she began working for Queen Anne's County School Public Schools as a Library Assistant at Queen Anne's County High School and Kent Island High School.

Mrs. Stinchcomb was an active member of the Kent Island United Methodist Church in Chester where she taught Sunday school, was a member of the church board, and the church librarian, and a member of the Bay City Ladies Club. She was a noted soccer mom with Queen Anne's Soccer and was treasurer for Commissioner Mark Belton.

She is survived by her husband, Earl Raymond Stinchcomb of Stevensville; son, Earl Wesley Stinchcomb of Stevensville; a daughter, Erin Elizabeth Stinchcomb of Stevensville; her parents, Robert W. and Jacqueline M. Priest of Arnold, MD; and a brother, Robert W. Priest of Reisterstown, MD.
