Diane Nack Schwarm went home with the Lord on September 1, 2014, after a long battle with cancer. She was 59. Born in Tarrytown, NY, on December 25, 1954, she was the daughter of Colonel and Mrs. John M. Nack, USA (Ret.) of Aberdeen, MD.

She graduated from Bremerhaven American High School, Germany in 1973. She received a BA degree from Seattle University in 1978. After moving to Easton in 1986, she attended and graduated from the Macqueen Gibbs Willis School of Nursing in 1991. Mrs. Schwarm worked in the Easton area as a Registered Nurse for 22 years. She was a member of Saints Peter and Paul Catholic Church in Easton.

In addition to her parents, Mrs. Schwarm is survived by her husband of 33 years, Rod; her two sons, Cory of Newark, DE, and Timothy of Catonsville, MD; two sisters; Kathleen of Mt.
