



Dolores Marie Faulkner

February 6, 1929 - April 24, 2015

Easton resident Dolores Marie Faulkner died on Friday, April 24, 2015, at Genesis HealthCare-The Pines in Easton, MD. She was 86.

Born in Brooklyn, NY, on February 6, 1929, she was the daughter of the late Louis and Camilla (Spelta) Guidone. She was the wife of Thomas James Faulkner, Jr., who died May 1, 2000.

Most important to her was her love of family, whom she always prayed for and kept close in her heart.

She is survived by her children, Thomas James Faulkner, III, James Lowery Faulkner (Judy), Mary Jean "Jeanie" Aydelotte (Mark); grandchildren, Melissa DiNapoli (Bobby), Lindsay Jean Faulkner, Meaghan Faulkner (fiancé Vinnie Dellano, and his daughter Victoria), Bryna Aydelotte (fiancé Ronald Scott), Kaitlin Finch (Tim); great-grandchildren, James Franco DiNapoli and baby girl Finch to be born in August.

She was looking forward to the birth of another great-grandchild and the two upcoming weddings of her grandchildren.

Dolores was a woman of great faith and believed strongly in giving of her time and generosity to her church, Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church. She was a Sunday school teacher for many years, often imparting difficult life lessons she learned from personal experience. She often visited the sick and also

lectored at daily Mass when she was able. She also made pilgrimages to Medjugorje in 1989 and Israel in 1995.

Dolores worked for the Easton Candy Company, the Easton Memorial Hospital as a medical secretary for Chief Radiologist Dr. Green, the Loyola Federal Savings and Loan as a teller and handling new accounts, Chase Manhattan Bank in New York as a teller, and at the National Institutes of Health as a medical secretary.

Her fondest work memories were her years at the United States Naval Academy, where she was a medical secretary for the cadets, who called her their second mom. She followed a class from Plebe to graduation and often still heard from "her boys" in later years. Later on she went to cosmetology school and worked at the Budget Shop for her friend, Peggy Wood. Dolores worked for both Dr. Ann Webb and Dr. Walid Kamsheh and as a medical secretary at Dorchester County Health Department. She also volunteered at Easton Memorial Hospital.

A Memorial Mass will be held at Sts. Peter & Paul Catholic Church on Saturday, May 16, 2015, at 10 a.m. Burial will be private.
