



Dominic F. Ferri

December 27, 1924 - December 15, 2013

Dominic Frances Ferri died on December 15, 2013, at Hospice of Queen Anne's. He was 88.

Mr. Ferri was born on December 27, 1924, to the late Dominic Ferri and Dominica Zamponi in Baltimore, MD. He was raised in Little Italy on Albemarle Street where he attended school at St. Leo's.

He served with the Army during WWII in Italy and received the Purple Heart. After he returned from the war, he began a career as a brick layer with local union #1 for 50 years. In 1953, he married Agnes Turek, and they would spend their summers on Kent Island. Then, in 1988, they made it their permanent home where Mr. Ferri worked for the Queen Anne's County Parks & Rec ground maintenance part-time.

Mr. Ferri was a member of the Sons of Italy in Baltimore and the American Legion post #278. He loved recreational crabbing, dancing, and playing pinochle.

He is survived by his daughter, Maryjoe Phillips and son-in-law, Thomas Phillips of Stevensville; granddaughter, Caroline Phillips; grandson, Tristan Phillips; and many nieces and nephews. Mr. Ferri was predeceased by his wife, Agnes, on June 2, 2011; and his brother, Gerard Joseph Ferri on

February 2012.

Funeral mass will be held at St. Christopher's Catholic Church, on Thursday December 19, 2013, at 11 a.m. Interment will follow at the Stevensville Cemetery.
