



## Don Handley

November 28, 1929 - January 19, 2012

Don Walker Handley of The Rest in Easton, MD, died Thursday, January 19, 2012. He was 82.

Born in Dayton, OH, on November 28, 1929, he was the son of Clark Walker Handley and Edna Mae Oldfather.

Raised in Eaton, OH, Don received his degree in Civil Engineering from Ohio State University. After completing O.C.S. in Rhode Island, he served as Atomic and Biological Chemical Officer for the 14th Naval District stationed in Hawaii during the Korean War. He retired as a Lieutenant Commander.

Don then relocated to Philadelphia where he became an engineer in the Department of Architecture and Engineering for the Philadelphia School District, a position he held until his retirement in 1993.

In 1958, he married Ann V. Briddell, originally of Baltimore, and they made their home in Springfield, PA. Don was an active and longtime member of the Covenant United Methodist Church in Springfield. His interests were many – he was a Boy Scout leader, loved building and flying radio controlled model aircraft with the Valley Forge Signal Seekers, and enjoyed flying his Cessna 150 out of Easton airport. For more than 20 years, he volunteered with the Waterfowl Festival and was a member of Ducks Unlimited.

Ann and Don retired to the Eastern Shore in 1992. Don spent many wonderful hours fishing, hunting, and sailing with Ann on the Miles River.

Survivors include his wife, Ann, of 53 years; son, David M. Handley of Tilghman; and a daughter, Karen E. McKinley (Michael A. McKinley) of Cambridge; a brother, Robert A. Handley of Gainesville, FL; a brother-in-law, Chuck Briddell (Lynn); a sister-in-law, Wink Cowee (Dan); and many nieces and nephews.

A celebration of Don's life will be held on Tuesday, January 24, 2012, at 3 p.m. at The Presbyterian Church of Easton, 617 N. Washington St., in Easton.
