



## Dona "Donney" Mae Schlotzhauer

September 25, 1924 - February 25, 2011

Dona "Donney" Mae Schlotzhauer passed away on Friday, February 25, 2011 at the Memorial Hospital in Easton. She was 86 years old.

Born September 25, 1924 in Queenstown, MD, she was a lifelong resident of the Eastern Shore and spent the last 10 years of her life at William Hill Manor in Easton. Mrs. Schlotzhauer was the daughter of the late, William Sterling and Susan Mansfield Sterling Boone. After attending school in Queen Anne's County she was a homemaker, a nursing assistant at The Pines and supply manager in central supply at the Memorial Hospital in Easton. She retired from her working career in 1981 to help care for her grandchildren.

She was a member of the Immanuel Lutheran Church in Easton and also a member of the American Parkinson's Disease Association.

Mrs. Schlotzhauer is survived by a son, Eugene Gerkin and his wife, Linda of Easton; two daughters, Susan Tull and her husband, David of Easton and Bertha Schlotzhauer Geib and her husband, Jay of Cordova. She is also survived by 10 grandchildren and several great-grandchildren. She was preceded in death by her husband of 46 years, Ernest Schlotzhauer and her six siblings.
