Donald F. Brown of Newcomb, MD died on Thursday June 26, 2008. He was 63. Born May 22, 1945 in Dothan, Alabama, he was the son of the late Robert Leonard and Myrtle Kingry Brown. He was raised in Manning, South Carolina and attended the University of South Carolina, later graduating from the Southern Business University in Georgia. Following four years of service in the U.S. Coast Guard, he married the former B. Faith Morris on November 28, 1970. He worked for the C & P Telephone Company for 27 years; retiring from Verizon in 2001.

Mr. Brown was a Past Exalted Ruler of the Easton Elks Lodge #1622. He was a co-founder of the Bay County Region Antique Automobile Club of America, a member of the Chesapeake Classic Car Club, Chesapeake Bay T's, and the Early V-8 Ford Club. He loved antique cars; riding in them and showing them at various car shows.

In addition to his wife, Mr. Brown is survived by a Godson; Brent Kuehne, two nieces; Katie Coursey and Christina Morris, and two nephews; Brian Morris and Cody Morris.

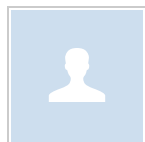
