Donald Allen Dadds, a lifelong resident of Centreville, Maryland, passed away on January 6, 2025, in Easton, Maryland, at the age of 86.

Born on March 27, 1938, to the late Bernard Franklin Dadds and Mary Louise Hessey, Donald grew up in Centreville alongside his four siblings. He graduated from Centreville High School in 1956 and soon after enlisted in the Army National Guard, proudly serving his country from 1959 until 1966.

Donald built a remarkable career marked by hard work and dedication. He served as a manager at Kent Island Acme, owned and operated Food Rite in Harrington, Delaware, also founded Dadds Deli in Centreville, Maryland. In his later years, he worked as a property manager in Ridgely, Maryland, until his well-deserved retirement.

An active member of his community, Donald was a past member of the Goodwill Fire Company in Centreville. His greatest joys in life were spending cherished time with his grandchildren and delivering donuts to his children every Sunday.

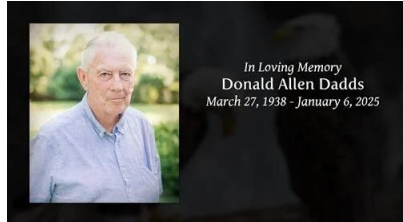
