



## Donald Patrick Doran

June 27, 1928 - April 1, 2013

Donald Patrick Doran, 84, of Queenstown, died Monday April 1, 2013 at The Hospice Center in Centreville.

Donald was born to the late Virginia G. Doran and Joseph P. Doran on the 27th of June, 1928 in Pittsburgh, PA. He began his career at Baltimore Gas & Electric in 1947 before enlisting in the Marine Corps in 1950. Donald later worked at Dopman Millwork before he began working at the Bainbridge Naval Training Center. He later transferred to the United States Naval Academy where he retired in 1984. Following his retirement, he began working for Anne Arundel County and retired from there in 1989.

Donald was a member of the Bay Country Moose Lodge and American Legion Post 296. He loved fishing and crabbing on the Wye River and enjoyed teaching his grandsons to do both. Donald was also an avid Baltimore Colts, Baltimore Ravens and Baltimore Orioles fan who rarely missed a game.

Donald is survived by his daughter Leslie Walters and son-in-law David Walters of Grasonville, his grandsons Brian Tyler of Easton and David Tyler of Stevensville, his granddaughters-in-law Kristen Tyler and Stephanie Tyler, his great-granddaughter Ava Tyler and his great-grandson Joseph (JP) Tyler.

Donald was preceded in death by his loving wife Shirley Doran and his siblings James Gist, Joseph Doran, John Doran and Katherine Barto.

A funeral service will be held at 11 am on Friday, April 5 at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Chester, where friends may visit with the family beginning at 10 am.

Burial will follow at Woodlawn Memorial Park in Easton, MD.
