Donald Steven Gertz of Queenstown, MD died on Wednesday, June 24, 2009 at Easton Memorial Hospital. Steven died of multiple complications due to a pulmonary embolism. He was 53 years old.

Steven was born on January 9, 1956 to Patricia Anthony and the late, Albert Howard Gertz, Jr. He grew up in Queenstown and attended Queen Anne's County High School. He worked as a carpenter in the area for various local builders. He married Bonnie Pinder in 1976 and they later divorced. He enjoyed playing softball, fishing, crabbing, and spending time on the water.

He is survived by his mother, Patricia Anthony Gertz of Queenstown, MD; a daughter, Stephanie Nicole Gertz of Queenstown, MD; a brother, Terry K. Gertz of Queenstown, MD and a granddaughter, Olivia Dawn Porter, also of Queenstown, MD. He is predeceased by a brother, Michael Duane Gertz who died in 1994.
