



## Donald Wanamaker Smith

Donald Wanamaker Smith of Cokesbury Village and Centreville, MD, passed away on Monday, September 11, 2000. He was 77.

He was born and lived in Bethlehem, PA, and graduated from the U.S. Naval Academy in 1945. He served in World War II on the USS Biloxi in the Pacific and on the Battleship North Carolina. He also taught in Annapolis during the Korean War. He joined the DuPont Company in 1948 and retired after 38 years. He was an enthusiastic member of the St. Albans Church choir and had served as treasurer of the Episcopal Diocesan Council of Delaware.

Mr. Smith is survived by his wife, the former Mary Morse whom he married in 1946; a daughter, Dana S. Tench of Cleveland, OH; a son, Daniel S. M. Smith of Denver, CO; and a grandson, Matthew J.M. Smith of Denver, CO.
