



## Donald Emerson Carlson

Donald Emerson Carlson of Crumpton, Maryland died on July 28, 2007 at his home. He was 56.

Born in Jamestown, NY on May 28, 1951, he was the son of Harriet Holm Carlson and the late, Paul Carlson. He sang in the church choir, was an eagle scout and spent time as a life guard and counselor at Chautauqua Lake while living in New York.

Mr. Carlson graduated from Jamestown High School in the Class of 1969, and Allegheny College in PA in 1973, earning a Bachelors in Psychology. He moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland in 1973 where he took courses towards a graduate degree at Washington College in Chestertown, MD. In 1992 he married Dorothy Ann Carpenter.

In addition to his wife and mother, he is survived by a daughter, Marta Bishop Carlson of Crumpton, MD; a son, Jaime Carpenter Horrigan and his wife, Julie Cymek of Savage, MD; a grandson, Jacob Parker Dalrymple of Crumpton, MD; two brothers, Rev. Charles Carlson of Minnesota and Bruce Carlson of New York; his mother in law, Merlaine Carpenter of Millersville, MD and many loving brothers and sisters in law and nieces and nephews.

Mr. Carlson has resided in Crumpton, MD for the past 20 years. He was a kitchen designer with Reico Kitchen and Bath, an accomplished musician

leading his family's band, Leda's Charm who performed regularly at Andy's in Chestertown and various venues in Annapolis, and a wood sculptor, displaying his work at the Artists Gallery in Chestertown. He was a previous part owner of Chesapeake Home Center. Mr. Carlson participated in international sculpture symposiums in France and Quebec.

In addition to his love of art, Mr. Carlson enjoyed kayaking, croquet, ping pong, cooking, gardening, as well as bird watching with his 3 year old grandson, Parker. He was working on a book of kayaking the Chester River.

A private celebration of his life will be led by his brother, Rev. Carlson.
