Donald Hillman Smith of St. Michaels, MD died on Wednesday, December 20, 2006 at Memorial Hospital at Easton, at the age of 63.

Born March 9, 1943 in Connellsville, PA; He was the son of the late Gerald Hillman Smith and Leonor Agnes Swiger Smith of Wheeling WV. After graduating from Suitland High School in 1961, he joined the U.S. Army, where he served on the United States rifle team. A distinguished marksman, he ranked in the top ten of the country.
