Donald J. Walters of Easton passed away at the Memorial Hospital at Easton on Sunday, August 6, 2006. He was 79.

Born in Baltimore on March 27, 1927 he was the son of the late Warren C. and Agnes Bradunus Walters. After attending Calvert Hall High School in Baltimore he enlisted in the U.S. Army where he was part of the European campaign. Following his release from active duty he began a career in the music business as a sales representative. In 1950 he married Gloria Leishear. They made their home in Catonsville, Baltimore, Co. until his retirement from CBS in 1983 when they moved to Easton, continuing their second career of carving and painting waterfowl which included demonstrations at the Easton Waterfowl Festival for many years. Together they owned and operated the Wood Duck Shoppe on Kent Island until moving the gallery to Easton. In the early 2000's he retired due to health reasons.

In addition to his beloved wife, Mr. Walters is survived by two sons; Donald "Doug" Walters of Catonsville, MD; and Michael J. Walters of Easton, MD; two brothers; Warren A. Walters of Baltimore, and James T. Walters of Owings Mills, MD; one sister; Carolyn Taylor, of Ellicott City, MD; four grandchildren; Michael Walters, Matthew Walters, Jessica Walters, Douglas P.A. Walters and three great grandchildren; Kelsey, Hunter and Nathan.
