Donald Lee Foster of Cordova, MD died on Thursday, August 12, 2004 at the Memorial Hospital, Easton, MD. He was 54.

Born January 30, 1950 in Easton, MD, he was the son of the late Earl Thomas Foster, Jr., Betty Foster Laird and his step-father, George "Babe" Laird. After graduating from St. Michaels High School in 1968, he worked a short time for Bay Shore Foods. He then served in the U.S. Navy in Vietnam on the aircraft carrier, U.S.S. America where he was an aircraft fuel specialist. Following his release from active duty he went to work for Elliott Wilson Trucks in Easton for 28 years until 2000 when he started his own business, known as Foster's Repairs in Cordova.

The most important thing in his life was spending time with his family.

He was a member of the E.E. Streets Memorial Post #5118 VFW, and Easton Elks Lodge #1622 BPOE.

Mr. Foster is survived by his wife the former, Agnes V. Johnson whom he married June 28, 1974; two children, Laura L. Collins and her husband, Rodney of Easton and Donald Lee Foster, Jr. and his fiancé, Meghan O'Neill; four sisters, Cathy Foster, Kay McQuay and Betty Ruth Shortall, and her husband, Bucky, all of St. Michaels and Brenda Wilson and her husband,

Robbie of Tilghman; one brother, Tommy Foster and his wife, Judy of Easton; two grandsons, R. Logan Collins and Mason Collins, numerous nieces, nephews and great nieces and nephews.

Funeral services will be held at the Easton Church of God on Tuesday, August 17, 2004 at 11:00 AM where friends may call Monday evening from 6 – 8 PM and one hour prior to the service.
