Donald Webster Smith, of Salisbury and formerly of Easton, died at the Hospice House, Easton on Wednesday, February 16, 2000. He was 66.

Born in Easton, August 11, 1933, he was the son of the late Ralph and Ellen Pauline Blake Smith. After graduating from Easton High School in 1951, he played minor league professional baseball until joining the U.S. Navy in April of 1952. Following his release from active duty in 1956, he made his home in Easton until moving to Salisbury in 1970, where he was a pressman for the Burroughs Corporation, which is now Standard Register. He retired in 1995.

Mr. Smith is survived by a daughter, Karen S. Schauber of Mechanicsburg, PA, and one granddaughter.

Funeral services will be held on Friday, February 18, 2000 at 2:00 PM at Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, Easton, where friends may call one hour prior to the service. Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
