Donna Marie Phelps of Centreville, MD, died Sunday, August 31, 2014, at Hospice of Queen Anne's in Centreville. She was 65.

Born on May 11, 1949, in Washington, DC, she was the daughter of the late Charles and Eileen Beers Tucker. She graduated from Elizabeth Seton High School and attended Prince Georges Community College. Upon her father's retirement from the District of Columbia Fire Department, she moved to Florida where she began work with the Department of Veterans Affairs. She returned to Maryland in 1983 to work for the VA Office of the Inspector General where she met and married Tom Phelps. She retired in 2002 as a Management Analyst with the Veterans Benefits Administration. When Tom retired they moved to the Eastern Shore of Maryland where she found great joy as a member of the Prospect Bay Country Club and the Women's Golf Association, the friendship and caring that she found there carried her through several health challenges and gave her unceasing support.
