Donna L. Fletcher of Chestertown, MD died on February 24, 2009 at her home. She was 49.

She was born on February 27, 1959 in NJ and moved to Chestertown at the age of 13. She was the daughter of Clyde "Pic" Conley and Pat Renshaw of Chestertown, MD. Mrs. Fletcher graduated Kent County High School class of 1977. She attended both Washington College and Chesapeake College where she took Banking Courses.
