Doris Foerster of Easton, died at the Memorial Hospital, Easton on Saturday, November 27, 2004. She was 86.

Born in Baltimore, on June 9, 1918 she was the daughter of the late James L. and Sarah Burch Chiveal. After graduating from public school in Baltimore City she worked as a telephone operator for C&P Telephone for many years. In 1946 she married George K. Foerster they resided in Baltimore until 1964, when they moved to Dorchester County, while living there she volunteered at White Oak Bible Camp in Woolford. In 1997 they moved to Easton. Mr. Foerster died in February 1998.

She was a member of the Women of the Moose, Easton, she was also a former member of the Methodist church in Woolford and the Church of the Nazarene in Easton.

Mrs. Foerster is survived by a sister, Elaine Adkins of Ft. Lauderdale, Fl; seven grandchildren that include Sarah E. Trice of Preston, Howard W. Fisher III of Cordova, and Sgt. Scott Wienhold of Ft. Bragg, N.C. and 16 great grandchildren. In addition to her husband she was predeceased by a son, Bernard C. Wienhold; a daughter Eva Elaine Fisher; two brothers and one sister.
