Doris "Bootsie" Mae Hunley passed away peacefully in her sleep on December 11, 2024 at the age of 84.

Doris was born on June 11, 1940, in Chestertown, Maryland, to the late Ruth Ann Wilson and Richard Allen Jones Sr. She grew up in Kent County, MD and graduated from the Henry Highland Garnet School in 1957. Doris had a long and dedicated career, working at various companies, including VitaFoods in Chestertown, the Lumar Factory in Dover DE, Allan Foods in Cordova MD, and Rose's in Chestertown MD, where she retired as a department head in 2007.
