



Doris Legg Yerkes

March 20, 1920 - August 6, 2014

Doris Virginia Yerkes of Rock Hall, MD, died on Wednesday, August 6, 2014, at Chestertown Nursing and Rehabilitation Center. She was 94.

Born on March 20, 1920, in Cliff City, MD, she was the daughter of the late Arthur T. and Edna V. Crouch Legg. On August 17, 1961, she married the late Lewis A. Yerkes and resided in St. Michaels. She began working at Traders Pharmacy in Easton for 22 years as a clerk. She and her husband later moved to Ocean City, MD, where she began working with her husband at Fountain Head as a receptionist in 1973. She retired there in 1990 and moved to Rock Hall in 1995.

Mrs. Yerkes is a member of Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church, the Rock Hall Volunteer Fire Company - Ladies Auxiliary, and the Rock Hall Senior Citizens. She enjoyed singing in the Wesley Chapel Choir, and attending Bible Study groups. Mrs. Yerkes was an avid reader, always having a book or a word search puzzle close by.

She is survived by many nieces and nephews. In addition to her husband, she was predeceased by five siblings, Richard T. Legg, John A. Legg, Mary Smith, Thomas Legg and Ruth Dickerson.

A memorial service will be held on Sunday, August 17, 2014, at 2 p.m. at

Wesley Chapel United Methodist Church, where relatives and friends may call one hour prior (1-2 p.m.). Interment will follow in Wesley Chapel Cemetery.

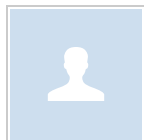
