Doris P. Mitchell of Denton died Tuesday, July 1, 2008 at the Caroline Home for Hospice. She was 84.

Born November 16, 1923 in Wilmington, DE, she was the daughter of the late, William H. and Dorothy McRae Peoples. Following her graduation from P.S. DuPont High School in Wilmington, DE, she attended nursing school at the Beebe Hospital in Lewes, DE where she graduated with her RN in 1944.

Following her marriage to Charles Stewart Mitchell, they lived in various places throughout Delaware, until moving to Maryland and later to Davenport, FL. Mrs. Mitchell worked as a registered nurse for the Memoiral Hospital at Easton for more than 16 years until her retirement. In 1985, she and her husband moved to Florida. Mr. Mitchell died in December 1995. In 2005, Mrs. Mitchell moved to Denton.

Surviving are her four children, Kenneth S. Mitchell of Bear, DE, Charles W. Mitchell of Denton, Karen McDowell and her husband, John of Charlottesville, VA and Barbara Mann and her husband, Mike with whom she made her home in Denton; a sister-in-law, Joan Peoples of Sarasota, FL; 13 grandchildren and 13 great grandchildren.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by a

daughter, Gail Baynard, who died in 1989.
