Dorothy Anne Robinet of Easton, MD and Bethesda, MD, died on August 4, 2007 at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 86.

Born in Washington DC, she was the daughter of the late Dr. Charles Wheatley, Capt. USN, and Frances Shane Wheatley. She attended Vanderbilt University where she was a Tri-Delt. A very talented and passionate artist, Dorothy Anne studied art at Washington's Corcoran College of Art and Montgomery Community College in Rockville, Maryland. During World War II she served overseas with the Red Cross in the European and Pacific theaters.

In 1945 she married Col. Alex J. Robinet at St. Johns Episcopal Church in Bethesda, MD, where for the past 32 years she had resided at Marion Lane and in Easton.
