



## Dorothy Dahlbom

October 3, 1918 - December 2, 2012

Dorothy S. Dahlbom of Chestertown, MD, died on December 2, 2012, at Chester River Hospital Center in Chestertown. She was 94.

She was born on October 3, 1918, in Brooklyn, NY, the daughter of the late John and Signe Carlson Michelson. Mrs. Dahlbom was a graduate of Manual Training High School in Brooklyn and Pace College in New York City.

She worked as a personal secretary in the banking industry with Bankers Trust in NYC. On June 29, 1940, she married Carl Albert Dahlbom. They resided in Brooklyn, NY, moved to Greenlawn, Long Island, where she raised her family. In 1962, she moved to Colts Neck NJ. Following Mr. Dahlbom's retirement, they moved to Heron Point in Chestertown in 1996.

Mrs. Dahlbom was a member of the Reformed Church of Colts Neck, NJ, and the Garden Club and Women's Club in New Jersey. She was a member of the Presbyterian Church of Chestertown.

She was predeceased by her husband in 2005 and a son, Alan Carl Dahlbom in 2004.

She is survived by her daughter, Carol Hagert and her husband Hugh of Centreville, MD; her daughter-in-law, Dianne Dahlbom of Arlington, MA; four

grandchildren, Christopher Hagert and his wife Christie of Purcellville, VA, Kristin Hagert of Centreville, MD, Eric Dahlbom of Arlington, MA, and David Dahlbom of Arlington, MA; along with two great-grandchildren, Harris Emily Hagert and Hudson James Hagert.
