



Dorothy May Daywalt

May 22, 1916 - May 3, 2017

Dorothy May Daywalt of Queenstown, MD, passed away peacefully at her home on May 3, 2017. She was 100.

Born in Baltimore, MD, on May 22, 1916, she was the daughter of the late Jeremiah Lawton and Mary Todd Boyd. She attended Jacobsville Elementary in Pasadena, MD, and graduated from Glen Burnie High School. On July 17, 1939, she married Alfred E. Daywalt and the couple made their home in Anne Arundel County.

During World War II, Mrs. Daywalt worked as an original "Rosie the Riveter" at the Glen L. Martin Air Craft Factory from 1942-1945. After the war, the Daywalts moved to High Point in Anne Arundel County, later moving to a farm in Crownsville, MD, where they lived for 20 years. Mrs. Daywalt worked at American Sugar Co. and later at Montgomery Ward. In 1987, the couple moved to their home in Queenstown, MD.

Mrs. Daywalt loved golfing and bowling. She was a life member of the Elks Lodge 622, the VFW Post 7464 Auxiliary, and served as a Senior Regent of the Ladies of the Moose, Lodge 296.

She is survived by her loving husband of 78 years, Alfred Daywalt; and four nephews. She was preceded in death by her eight siblings.

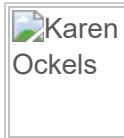
