



Dorothy "Dolly" Mae Bramble

June 6, 1931 - December 28, 2021

Dorothy "Dolly" Mae Bramble passed away on December 28, 2021, at UMSMC-Easton. She was 90.

Dolly was born on June 6, 1931, in Easton, MD, the daughter of the late Arlie A. Mullikin and Sarah Madge Usilton Mullikin.

After high school, Dolly held many positions, working at Tack & Betty Restaurant and Atkinsons, and spent many years working at the family business--Bramble Body Shop. In addition to her work and caring for her family, Dolly spent countless hours volunteering with the Ladies Auxiliary at Easton Memorial Hospital, volunteering at St. Mark's Thrift Store, and helping to set up the library at St. Mark's. In her free time, Dolly was an avid painter and art enthusiast. She also enjoyed learning about and exploring history and her family genealogy.

Dolly is survived by her husband of 72 years, D'Arcy E. Bramble, Sr., whom she married on June 18, 1949. She is also survived by her son, D'Arcy Bramble Jr. and his wife, Donna Marie of Easton; her grandchildren, Amanda Bramble, Caroline Phillips (Drew), and Christopher Bramble; great grandchildren, Ellie Mae and Charlotte Ann; her sister, Peggy Shores of Cordova; brothers, Louis Mullikin (Andrea) of Easton, Temple Mullikin (Kathy), of Clovis, CA, Melvin Mullikin (Chris) of Easton, and sister-in-law Jackie

Mullikin, of Federalsburg; Nicole Lewis (Jason) and Michael Foster (Heather) and their children who were like grandchildren to her; and many nieces and nephews. She was preceded in death by her grandson, Nicholas E. Bramble; brother, Charles Arlie Mullikin; and niece, Peggy Karen Shores.

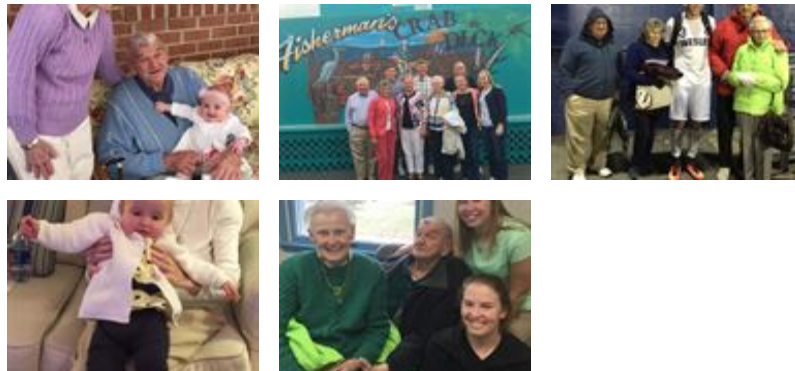
