Dorothy Mary Klages of Easton, MD died on Friday November 1, 2013 at the Anne Arundel Medical Center in Annapolis, MD. She was 77.

Mrs. Klages was born in Baltimore, MD on June 6, 1936 to the late William P. and Evelyn Gunkel Lippert.

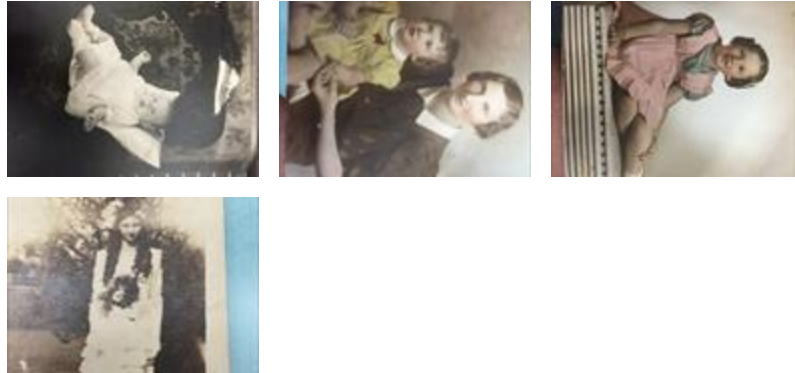
