Dorothy A. Mann, of St. Michaels, Maryland, died on October 12, 2022, at the age of 96.

Born in Tarentum, PA on December 30, 1925, she was the daughter of William Leonard and Alene Elizabeth Biederman Allen. She had two brothers, William G. Allen and Robert L. Allen, both of Naples, FL, who predeceased her.

Dorothy was a resident of St. Michaels for over 35 years. On October 5, 1985, she married John W. Mann Jr., who predeceased her.
