



Dorothy Rebecca Morlock

September 10, 1932 - June 8, 2013

Dorothy Rebecca Morlock, also known as “Dot” or “Dottie” of Rock Hall, MD, died Saturday, June 8, 2013 at the Hospice of Queen Anne’s, Inc. in Centreville, MD. She was 80.

Dottie was born September 10, 1932, in Media, PA, the daughter of the late George W. Mooney and Dorothy Rebecca Leaver Mooney. Mrs. Morlock was a 1950 graduate of Nether Providence High School. In 1953, she received her Nursing degree from the Presbyterian Hospital School for Nurses in Philadelphia. Upon graduation, she worked as a nurse at Fair Acres in Delaware County, PA.

She married Richard Morlock on June 11, 1955 and the two started a family together. Mrs. Morlock worked as a Registered Nurse for Kent and Queen Anne’s Hospital, Magnolia Hall, and was retired from the Upper Shore Mental Health. Her interests included reading, gardening, painting with watercolors, traveling, crocheting, knitting, and sewing. She volunteered her time in many areas, such as the Upper Shore Mental Health, Rock Hall Library, Friends of the Kent County Public Library Book Sale, Voter Registration, and taught crocheting and knitting at the Amy Lynn Ferris Senior Center. She supported the Upper Shore Mental Health remaining open to serve the community and testified in Annapolis during the hearing process.

Dottie is survived by her husband of 58 years, Richard W. Morlock of Rock Hall, MD; one daughter, Beth Brandenburg of York Springs, PA; one son, Richard G. Morlock of Rock Hall, MD; one sister, Elizabeth Mooney of Brattleboro, VT; and three grandchildren, Connor and Lauren Brandenburg of York Springs, PA and Charles Morlock of Rock Hall, MD. She adored spending time with her grandchildren, was devoted to her husband and home, her dogs, and living on the Eastern Shore.

A graveside service will be held on Saturday, June 15 at 10 a.m. in Wesley Chapel Cemetery, Rock Hall, MD.

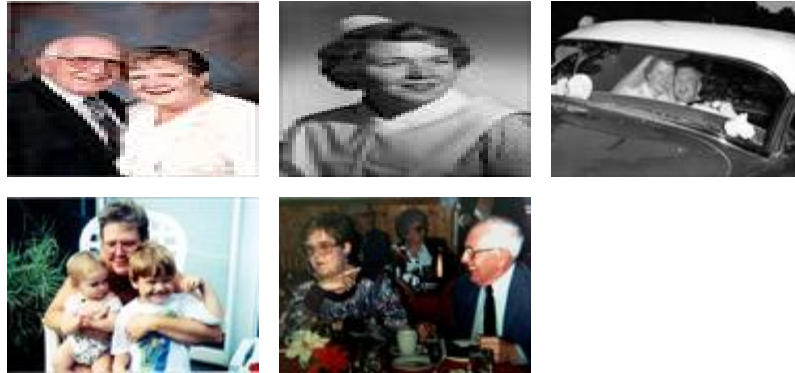
