



Ms Dorothy Kay Perkins

August 19, 1943 - February 22, 2012

Dorothy Kay Perkins of Baltimore died on February 22, 2012 at John Hopkins, Bayview surrounded by her loving family. She was 68.

Born in Centreville on August 19, 1943, she was the daughter of the late, Louis Hunter and Dorothy Keith Perkins. She grew up with her siblings on Chester Farm outside of Centreville, where large family gatherings were frequent. A 1961 graduate of Centreville High School, Ms. Perkins attended Salisbury University. She spent her career in the health care industry in Baltimore City, and continued her education while working. Later, she worked in the insurance industry until her retirement in 2006.

Ms. Perkins was very involved in animal rescue, especially working with cats. She was a good friend and neighbor to many and enjoyed the social time she spent with friends and family. Through the years she visited Centreville often and always had close ties to her Eastern Shore heritage

She is survived by a sister, Ellen Anderson and her husband, Gilbert, of Oxford; a brother, John Perkins and his wife, Phyllis, of Centreville; her niece, Jennifer Eason and her husband, Ritchy, of Oxford; two great-nephews, Will and Brennen Eason; numerous cousins; and many great friends in the Baltimore area.

A funeral service will be held at 12:00 noon on Saturday, February 25 at the Fellows, Helfenbein & Newnam Funeral Home, P.A. in Centreville, where friends may call one hour prior to the service.
