



## Dorothy Frances Santangelo

July 9, 1937 - August 8, 2012

Dorothy F. Boardman Santangelo of Rock Hall, MD, died on August 8, 2012, at Memorial Hospital at Easton. She was 75.

She was born in Brooklyn, NY, on July 9, 1937, the daughter of the late, Ralph and Rose Calia Boardman. She was a graduate from Ft. Hamilton High School and attended New York University. She married Robert B. Santangelo on September 28, 1958. They made their home in Brooklyn and later Merrick, NY, for 30 years where she raised her family and taught astrology. In September of 1991, she and her husband moved to Rock Hall where they opened and operated Moonlight Bay Inn and Marina.

Mrs. Santangelo was a member of St. John's Catholic Church in Rock Hall, the Greater Rock Hall Business Association, and Kent County Lodging Association. She also authored several books on astrology. Her hobbies included cooking, astrology, and decorating. She enjoyed her family and her guests at Moonlight Bay.

Her husband predeceased her in July of 2010. She is survived by her three sons, Mark Santangelo and his wife, Amy of Woodstock, MD, Rob Santangelo of Rock Hall, MD, and Jeffrey Santangelo of Rock Hall, MD; a daughter-in-law, Marie Santangelo of Centreville, MD; and grandchildren, Gabrielle, Zachary, Nicholas, and Amber.
