Obituary for Dorothy Mary (Twyman) Straub

Dorothy Mary Straub, the daughter and last surviving child of John David Twyman and Louise Helen Victoria (Tarling) Twyman, was born on 6 June 1924, in Brooklyn, New York. She was educated in New York City public schools and graduated from Bushwick High School. During World War II she worked as a secretary for the Federal Radio Corporation, which became ITT. There she met her husband of fifty years, Stephen Joseph Straub, who predeceased her. They raised their family in Union, New Jersey, and in retirement lived in Lakehurst, New Jersey. During her married life she was a homemaker, volunteer, avid gardener and world traveler.
