



## Dorothy Anna Vogel Rowe

March 20, 1919 - May 22, 2018

Dorothy Anna Vogel Rowe, of Easton, MD, died on Tuesday, May 22, 2018, at Bayleigh Chase in Easton. She was 99 years old.

She was born on March 20, 1919, in Baltimore City, MD, the daughter of the late William Henry and Leila Tracey Vogel. Mrs. Rowe grew up in Towson and graduated from Towson High School and Maryland State Teachers College (Towson University). She taught in Baltimore County Public Schools and McDonogh School.

She married the late William Albert Rowe, Jr. on September 29, 1945.

She served as Deacon and a first woman elder in the Towson Presbyterian Church. Her other church responsibilities included; President of the Woman's Association, planning and building committees, newsletter editor, and choir member.

They moved to Easton in 1980, and she was active in the Presbyterian Church of Easton, Memorial Hospital Auxiliary, and the Historical Society of Talbot County.

She is survived by her children, William Albert Rowe, III, and his wife Mary Ellen, and Carol Elizabeth Rowe Sanborn and her husband, Gregg; and two

grandsons, William Albert Rowe, IV, and Brian Barry Rowe.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband William Albert Rowe, Jr., who died in 2006.

A private graveside service will be held at St. Paul's Episcopal Church Cemetery in Chestertown. A memorial service will be held on Friday, May 25, 2018, at 2 p.m. at the Presbyterian Church of Easton.
