July 8, 1929 - January 10, 2009

Dorothy Ann White died at her home in Bozman, MD on Saturday January 10, 2009. She was 79.

Born July 8, 1929 in Latrobe, PA, she was the daughter of the late Wilbur Smith and Lillian Smith Fowler. After graduating from the Latrobe Nursing School, she began a 45 year career as a registered nurse.

She was a resident of Temple Hills, MD for 36 years prior to moving to Bozman, where she has resided for 13 years. Mrs. White spent her time volunteering at the Regional Cancer Center and the Talbot Hospice Foundation and was a member and Treasurer of The Talbot County Women's Club.

Mrs. White is survived by her husband William A. White of 57 years, whom she married April 19, 1952; six children, Chaz White and his wife Kelly, Jim White and his wife Kathy, Marjean Cefaratti and her husband Ray, Jo Ann Rubenstahl and her husband Joe, Gail Romine, and Kyle White and his wife, Terry; fifteen grandchildren, one great-grandchild, two sisters, two brothers, and a host of nieces, nephews, and friends. She was predeceased by one sister, Marge Dibert.
