Dorothy B. Larmore “Dottie” of Easton died Friday, August 10, 2007, at the Talbot Hospice House. She was 72.

Born on August 22, 1934, in West Chester, PA, she was the daughter of J. Arlington and Elizabeth Baumgartner Bennett.

She graduated from MacQueen Gibbs Willis School of Nursing in 1955, and was the past president of MGW Alumni Association. After attending Johns Hopkins University, she worked at the Memorial Hospital at Easton for thirty years, and the Delmarva Foundation for ten years.

Dottie was a member of the St. Mark’s United Methodist Church in Easton and served as a member of the alter guild, communion steward, usher, and the coordinator of coffee hour. She was also a member of the Wesley- Yater Bible class. She enjoyed playing English handbells, during her time as a member of the St. Mark’s Handbell choir from its inception in the early eighties to the present. Handbells brought her comfort during difficult times, especially during her final illness. Recently, she had become part of an ensemble group the “Glory Ringers.”

Dottie was a current member and past board member of the auxiliary of the Memorial Hospital at Easton, a volunteer at the Festival of Trees, and a

member of Ladies of the Elks Lodge # 1622 serving as their president for the year 2005- 2006.

Her husband Elwood A. Larmore whom she married on June 22, 1974, died December 18, 2001.

Dorothy is survived by her son A. Dixon Fountain III, four step children: Deborah Skipper and her husband Kevin, Bridgett Ranacinghe and her husband Danthe, Wendy Lankford and her husband Gorman, Elwood (Lonnie) Larmore Jr. and his wife Pam, seven step grandchildren, and five step great grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Thursday, August 16, 2007, at 11:00 A.M. at St. Mark's United Methodist Church. Easton.
