



## Dorothy "Dolly" Price Benton Cissel

November 18, 1916 - July 16, 2010

Dorothy "Dolly" Price Benton Cissel passed away Friday, July 16, 2010 at Corsica Hills Nursing Home in Centreville, MD. She was 93. Born in Centreville, MD on November 18, 1916 was a lifelong resident. She was the daughter of the late, Howard E. and Mae Hall Price.

In 1933 she graduated from Centreville High School and in 1935 from Goldey Beacom Business College in Wilmington, DE.

From 1935 – 1951 she was the secretary for the University of Maryland Extension Service in Centreville, MD. From 1951 – 1982 she was bookkeeper for the Queen Anne's Soil Conservation District and also conducted a mimeograph business at her home. For 13 years she was bookkeeper for the Queen Anne's County Library.

In the late 1930's she was a member of the Little Theatre in Centreville. She was a charter member of the former Jr. Woman's Club, a member of the former Double X Homemaker's Club and also a member of the Tuesday Girls, a group interested in crafts.

She belonged to the Centreville Bridge Club, Centreville High School Alumni Association, Centreville United Methodist Church and was a longtime volunteer at the Corsica Hills Nursing Home in Centreville, MD.

On her 90th birthday in 2006 she was presented with a key to the town of Centreville and in 2008 she was the honoree of the Centreville High School Alumni Association.

In 1939 she married F. Dudley Benton, who died in 1985, and remarried in 1987 to Chester M. Cissel, Sr. who died in 1997.

She is survived by two children, W. Edward Benton, of Carmel, IN and Judith B. Plotz of Marriottsville, MD; four step children, Mary Alice Turncock of Winnipeg, Canada, Joanne C. Doyle of Salisbury, MD, Edwin I. Cissel of Vienna, VA and Chester M. Cissel, Jr. of Centreville, MD; 2 grandchildren, Jeffery and Michael Benton; 10 step grandchildren and 14 step great grandchildren.

Three brothers, John Hall Price, Ellsworth Price and Howard Price and three sisters, Ida Price, Rachel Tamblyn and Anna Rhodes are all deceased.

Funeral service will be held 11AM on Thursday, July 22, 2010 at the Centreville United Methodist Church, 608 Church Hill Road, Centreville, MD 21617 interment will follow at Chesterfield Cemetery in Centreville, MD. A visitation will be held Wednesday, July 21, 2010 from 6PM to 8PM at the Fellows, Helfenbein and Newnam Funeral Home, P. A., 408 South Liberty Street, Centreville, MD 21617.
