Dorothy E. Jewell (nee Teichen) of Baltimore, MD died Sunday, January 3, 2010. Beloved wife of Thomas G. Jewell, Architect, devoted mother of sons, Thomas Michael Jewell and his wife, Joann (Jody) of Baltimore, MD, and Steven Douglas Jewell of Grasonville, MD. She is also survived by her loving sister, Shirley C. Jacek and her husband, Tom of West Chicago, Illinois and many nieces and nephews. She was born in Elmhurst, Illinois, raised in Aurora, graduated from West Aurora High School in 1952, received her R.N. degree from St. Charles Hospital School of Nursing in 1955, attended DePaul University, later moved to Baltimore and married Tom Jewell in Aurora, Illinois on June 15, 1957. Mrs. Jewell was a Pediatric Head Nurse, Halsted 3 at John Hopkins Hospital until 1958. Continuing her education, she attended McCoy College at John Hopkins University, and Mt. St. Agnes College. She was President of the Women's Architectural League of Baltimore in 1970, enjoyed singing in the Handel Choir, summers on the Eastern Shore, and trips to Hawaii. From 1978-1986 she was the School Nurse at Seton High School, Charles Street, participated volunteering at GBMC, The Cardinal Shehan Center Hospice Care, Keswick Adult Day Care and tutored adult reading at The Learning Bank.
