



Dorothy Haig Brown

March 6, 1924 - January 2, 2011

Dorothy Haig Brown died peacefully on January 2, 2011, after suffering a small stroke shortly before Thanksgiving. She was 86 years old.

Mrs. Brown was born in Philadelphia. She graduated from Friends Central School and received a degree in chemistry from Tufts College. She married Norman H. Brown on March 18, 1943. They lived in Philadelphia and its suburbs until 1985 when her husband retired from the practice of law in order that they might spend some time cruising on their sailboat while still physically able to do so. They sold their house, put most of its contents in storage and moved onto the boat. In addition to extensive cruising in the Chesapeake, they were able to cruise the East coast from the Bay of Fundy to the Dry Tortugas (at the end of the Florida keys) and they also got to a few of the Caribbean Islands. In 1988 they decided it was time to re-establish a shore base and moved to St. Michaels, where they lived on Chestnut Street for four years and then moved to Martingham.

Mrs. Brown was an avid tennis player until late in her life and even after her tennis days were over, remained an avid gardener who always surrounded her home with an abundant garden.

She is survived by her husband, of 67 years, Norman H. Brown, four children: Cornelia Brown, Haig Brown, Oliver Brown and Willa B. Schell, and nine grandchildren. Although her descendants are scattered around the Northeast states, all four of her children and seven of her nine grandchildren were able to visit her in the last few days of her life.

Interment will be private. A memorial gathering in suburban Philadelphia is planned for mid January.
