Dorothy Lewis Bryant, 87, mother of two and a retired homemaker, office manager, and hospital volunteer, died May 23, 2001 at Heron Point in Chestertown, Md.

Mrs. Bryant was born in Bayonne, New Jersey the daughter of Frances and Leonard H. Lewis. She graduated from St. Aloysius Academy, Jersey City and attended Columbia University, New York City. She worked for the National Broadcasting Company in New York City before her marriage to Frederick B. Bryant and move to the Washington DC area in 1941.

From 1965 to 1991 she worked as office manager to Dr. Margaret J. Rioch, a well-known clinical psychologist. She served as a Red Cross volunteer at Suburban Hospital in Bethesda for 21 years. She was also a long-time member of the Chevy Chase Women's Club, where she was active in the Drama Section and served in a number of positions in the club, including membership chairman, recording secretary, and publicity chairman.

In 1991, Mrs. Bryant and her husband moved to Chestertown, Md. where, after 52 years of marriage, Mr. Bryant died in 1994. She is survived by two daughters, Carolyn Bryant and Christy Bryant Bumanis, both of Washington and by nephews and nieces in St. Catharines, Ontario and Virginia Beach, Virginia.

A Memorial service will be held on Tuesday, May 29, 2001 at 2:30pm at Heron Point.
