Dorothy M. Shreve, formerly of Tilghman, died on February 2, 2011 at the Memorial Hospital in Easton. She was 77 years old.

Born in Baltimore on August 26, 1933, she was the daughter of the late, Earl B. Haines and Rose E. Connelly Haines. She attended Forest Park High School and, on October 9, 1954, married Raymond D. Shreve.
