Dorothy Taylor Campher of Chestertown, MD died at her home on Saturday, September 25, 2004. She was 86.

Born in April of 1918, Chestertown, MD, she was the daughter of the late William E. and Sarah Mariah Wilson Taylor. After graduating from Garnett High School she attended Morgan State College where she earned a degree in Elementary Education. She worked with the Anne Arundel County School system for the majority of her teaching career, eventually serving as Principal. She later worked with the Cecil County School system and following her retirement she served as assistant Principal at the Cecilton Elementary School. In 1967 she married Elmer E. Campher and they lived in Morgnec, Kent County, MD.

She was a member of the O.E.S., Chapter #4 where she served as Grand Worthy Matron, served as Lay Speaker for Joshua Chapel, Asbury and Mt. Pleasant Churches where she was on the Board. She was also a member of Retired Teachers Association. She loved cooking, spending time with her family and helping others.

Mrs. Campher is survived by a sister, Bertha Taylor Pierce of Wilmington, DE and a host of nieces, nephews and cousins
