Dorothy Whiteley Hancock, of Easton, died at The Memorial Hospital at Easton on Wednesday, June 12, 2002. She was 94.

Born in Talbot County, January 4, 1908, she was one of twelve children of the late Robert J. and Georgianna Boyles Patchett. After attending public school she, on December 24, 1924, married Carlton R. Whiteley. They owned and operated a grocery store in Easton until 1931 when they began a wholesale company known as Easton Candy Company. Following Mr. Whiteley's death in 1959, she continued with their sons in the business and served as Vice President and Secretary of the company until its sale in 1984.

A lifelong resident of Talbot County, she was a charter member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church, a member of the United Methodist Women of the church, a member of the Ladies of the Elks, Easton Lodge #1622 and a former member of the Talbot Soroptomist.

Her second husband, Ernest J. Stoll whom she married in April of 1961, died in February of 1973.

Her third husband, Thomas J. Hancock whom she married in December of 1975, died in November of 1992.

Mrs. Hancock is survived by two sons, Harold Lee Whiteley of Cambridge and G. Allen Whiteley of Easton; six grandchildren and thirteen great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, June 15th, at 11 A. M. at St. Mark's United Methodist Church, Easton.

Burial will be at Spring Hill Cemetery, Easton.
