October 3, 1978 - February 4, 2009

Douglas Foster Estelow of Centreville, MD, died suddenly as a result of an auto accident on Wednesday, February 4, 2009. He was 30 years old.

Born on October 3, 1978, in Mt. Holly, NJ, he was the son of Donald Horace Estelow and Janet Lemke Estelow. He graduated from Southern Regional High School, Class of 1997 where he was active in golf, track and DECA. He also refereed basketball in Stafford Basketball Association. He received his AA degree from Ocean County College in Toms River, NJ, and his Bachelor of Science degree from Philadelphia University in Philadelphia, PA.

On November 4, 2006, he married Courtney Carroll of Centreville, MD. In May 2006, he and his wife started an office supply business in Centreville called "Caboodle Cartridge." He was a member of the International Fraternity of Delta Sigma Pi where he held many offices including National District Director, St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Queen Anne's County Chamber of Commerce, and Business Network International.

Mr. Estelow is survived by his wife, Courtney Estelow of Centreville, MD; his parents, Donald and Janet Estelow of Manahawkin, NJ; maternal grandparents, H. John and June Lemke of Moorestown, NJ; and a brother, Randy D. Estelow and his wife, Vanessa, of Manahawkin, NJ.

A memorial service will be held at 12 p.m. on Monday, February 9, 2009, at St. Paul's Episcopal Church, Centreville, MD.
