February 17, 1944 - October 21, 2011

Douglas Robert McClean, Sr., of Chestertown, MD, died on Friday, October 21, 2011, at his home. He was 67 years old.

Mr. McClean was born on February 17, 1944, in Baltimore, MD. He was the son of the late Charles Louis and Anna Eleanor (nee Moesta) McClean. Mr. McClean graduated from Baltimore City College in 1961 and joined the United States Coast Guard and served on the USCGC Westwind. On August 28, 1965, he married his wife, Pamela (nee George) McClean of Cumberland, MD.

He managed the family business, McClean Brother's Marine Supply, from 1965- 1993. After the family business was sold, he worked for Johnson & Towers and then the MD State Police, managing their electronics inventory. Mr. McClean was a member of Trinity Lutheran Church in Chestertown, MD. He enjoyed American history, especially the Civil War period and Baltimore history. He enjoyed family activities, boating, music, walking, and exercising. Prior to retiring and relocating to Chestertown, he resided in Pasadena, MD. He attended St. Paul's Lutheran Church of Glen Burnie, where he was actively involved in various ministries.

In addition to his wife, he is survived by his daughter: Jennifer (Charles) Pierce of Pasadena, MD; his sons: Douglas (Susan) McClean, Jr., of Airville,

PA, and Michael (Beth) McClean of Pasadena, MD; his brother: the Rev. Charles Louis McClean, Jr. of Alexandria, VA; and nine grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held on Tuesday, October 25, 2011, at 11 a.m. at the Trinity Lutheran Church, 101 Greenwood Avenue Chestertown, MD 21620 where relatives and friends may call on Monday, October 24, 2011, from 6 p.m. to 8 p.m. and on Tuesday from 9:30 a.m. to 10:30 a.m. Interment will be in Chester Cemetery following the service.
