Douglas Haswell Pike, co-founder of the Pike Agency, a New Jersey insurance brokerage firm, died at his home of cancer on Saturday, October 20, 2001. He was 77. He was the beloved husband of Gladys Nordquist Pike, to whom he was married for 51 years.

Prior to moving to Easton, in 1998, the couple lived in Boston, MA, where he worked as an insurance consultant and also co-founded ACS, an insurance claims service company, in Winchester, MA. Throughout his career he was involved in several other business enterprises. He attended Rutgers University prior to enlisting in the United States Marine Corps in 1943. During WWII he served in the Pacific Theater of Operations.

In Easton, he was a member of St. Mark's United Methodist Church. An avid golfer, he was a member of Baltusrol Golf Club, NJ, Pine Valley Golf Club, NJ, Easton Club and Talbot Country Club.

He was a loving father to three daughters, Cynthia P. Boynton of Nantucket, MA, Deborah Emmett-Pike of Scituate, MA and Dr. Judith E. Pike of Salisbury, MD. He is also survived by seven grandchildren, Matthew, Lauren, Douglas, Erik, Katherine, Theo and Eloise.
