Dr. Evert Ford Warren of Chestertown, MD died on December 26, 2001 at Heron Point in Chestertown. He was 85.

Born in Baltimore, Maryland on May 1, 1916, he was the son of the late George Townsley and Fannie S. Ford Warren.

Dr. Warren was a 1934 graduate of Central High School and a 1938 graduate of the Pennsylvania School of Optometry in Philadelphia. On June 20, 1942 he married the former Elizabeth Ann Kinsman of Chevy Chase, Maryland.

During World War II he served as an officer in the U.S. Coast Guard in the North Atlantic for 2 years and the Pacific Theatre for one year, he then served in the USCG reserves until he was honorably discharged in 1958.

Dr. Warren resided in Arlington, Va. and practiced in Washington D.C. until 1970 when he moved the practice to Tyson's Corner, Va. They retired to Heron Point Chestertown, Md. in 1991.

Dr. Warren held many high offices in various optometric organizations during his career and was a Past Master of Potomac Lodge #5 A.F.A.M. He enjoyed woodworking, traveling, sailing, and flying airplanes.

In addition to his wife of 59 years, he is survived by two sons: Dr. Robert Howe Warren of Fairfax, VA and E. James Warren of Austin, TX, eight grandchildren, and one great-grandson.

Memorial services will be held at Wesley Hall in Heron Point, Chestertown, MD on Saturday, January 12, 2002 at 2 PM.
