Dr. Kathryn "Kay" Haney Godwin, 81 of Shell Point Retirement Community, Ft. Myers, FL passed away on December 8, 2003. She was born July 14, 1922 in Bergholz, Ohio.

Kay served her country with distinction in the U.S. Navy during WWII and in the U.S. Air Force during the Korean War. She was employed for 30 years at the University of Maine serving 10 of those as Director of the Bureau of Public Administration. Kay earned her Doctor of Educational Administration degree there in 1989. While at the University, she developed the concept of the Senior Executive Service for the State, directed the New England Management Institute, had total responsibility for State of Management Internship Program, and helped established the Margaret Chase Smith Center for Public Affairs.

Upon her retirement in 1998, Kay moved to Shell Point Retirement Community, where she became a member of the Christian and Missionary Alliance as well as an active member of the Shell Point Community.
